No Person is an Object

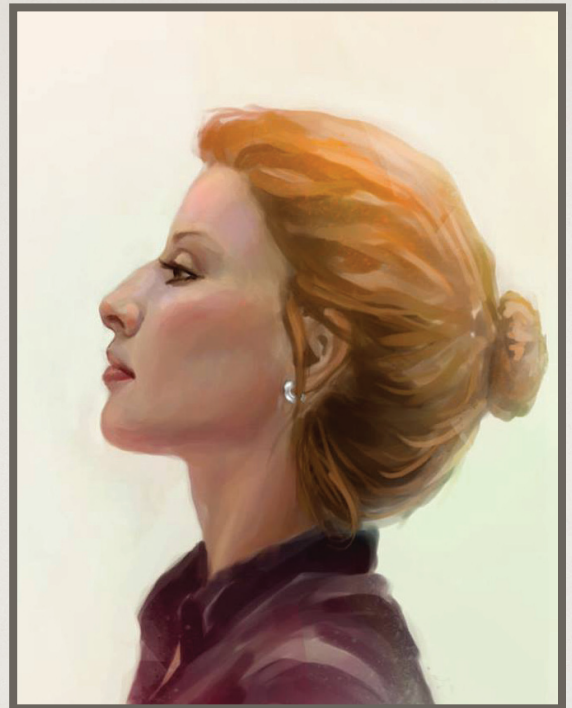
